- ♣ Explanation: Jacob's other name is "Israel."The Patriarchs were the first ones to follow Jesus.

# Week 2: Blue candle - Prophets

- ₱ *Phrase:* Prepare the way of the Lord!
- Explanation: The Prophets help the people listen to God.

#### Week 3: Pink candle - Mary

- ♣ Phrase: Your will be done!
- \* Explanation: Mary is Jesus' mother. She listened to God. Mary brought Jesus into the world.

## Week 4: Blue candle - Shepherds

- ₱ Phrase: Joy to the world!
- **★** *Explanation:* The shepherds waited in the still and quiet of the night. They were ready to hear the angels' good news.

#### Christmas Day: White candle - Jesus

- ₱ *Phrase:* Jesus is born! Immanuel! God with us!
- ₱ Explanation: God loves us very much, and sent his Son to lead us to him
